Rifle and Ammo Information:

- Any traditional single-shot or lever action rifle, .375 caliber or larger (lever actions must be single loaded).
- No hooked butt plates or palm rests.
- Same rifle (with same barrel) must be shot at all targets.
- Any metallic sight (separate scope class available).
- Cast bullets only (gas checks okay). **NO COATED BULLETS NO shooting jacketed bullets.**
- Any safe powder charge (black, black substitute, smokeless or duplex). **No over-powder wads of any kind allowed with double-based smokeless powder. Trapdoor loads cannot exceed published Level 1 load data.** Black powder loads are strongly recommended for all antique rifles.
- Standard gun safety procedures dictate that antique rifles be inspected by a knowledgeable person to ensure their reliable and safe operation. Please comply.

Match Information:

- Registration will be conducted Monday thru Friday, 9am-8pm at the match headquarters. Registration will include assignment to a shooting group.
- **YOU MUST BE REGISTERED BEFORE YOU SHOOT ON THE QUIGLEY RANGE FOR PRACTICE.**
- **The cost to register is \$50.00.**
- The squadding process (match shooting order) will be conducted on Friday from 1-6 pm by scorekeepers.
- A first-time shooters clinic will be held at 6pm Wednesday-Thursday-Friday evenings.
- Eight shots taken at each of 6 metal targets over the two-day event. 48 shots for score.
- Four targets will be shot on Saturday and the two remaining targets will be shot on Sunday. This procedure will be explained at the shooter's meeting Saturday morning at 8:30am – Match to start after shooters meeting. Sunday shoot will start at 9am.
- Targets are from 350 to 805 yards. All shooting is from sitting cross-sticks except off-hand at 350-yard target. No backrests unless physically required by the shooter to be able to participate in the match.
- Sighting in and practice is permitted 8am to 8pm Monday thru Friday of match week once you are registered. Sighting in allowed from 6:30am-8am on match mornings. **No sighter shots during the match.**
- Scorekeepers only call hits and misses. Only one spotter/coach per shooter is allowed.
- The target area is off limits **always!** All lead becomes the property of the Forsyth Rifle & Pistol Club.

- **International Champion** will be all international shooters (no scope).
- **Top First Time Quigley Shooter** all First-Time Quigley shooters (no scope) (2 places).
- **Top Scoped Rifle** (period scopes only) compete in their own category. And not for any other awards other than sign-up matches. (3 places)

Iron sight shooters will sign up for only one category in their age group.

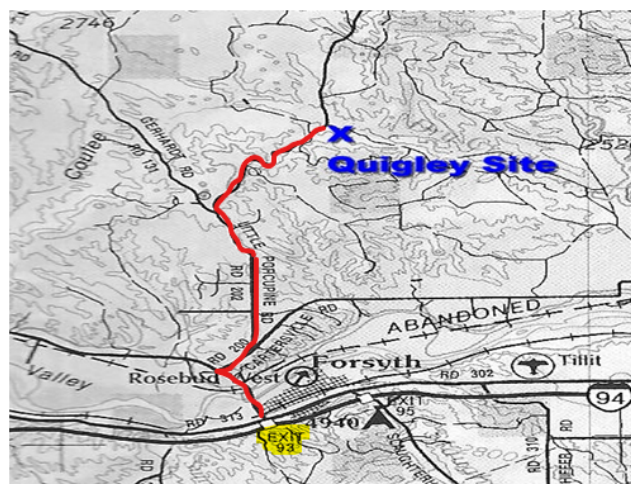

Quigley Safety Policy for Smokeless Shooters

If you shoot any double-based smokeless powder, we do not consider loads using an over-powder wad (cotton, Dacron, card wad, and whatever) as a safe load. We have had cotton balls and toilet paper catch the grass on fire. Most popular at the Quigley is AA 5744. It is designed to not be position sensitive in the cartridge case and needs no over powder wad for accuracy. Do not bring any such loaded cartridges as match or practice ammunition.
